Financial support for the Undergraduate Women in Economics RCT came from the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation through grant no. G-2014-14504. In the past three years, the only financial support I have received, other than my salary from Harvard University, is:

1. NBER, co-director of the Gender in the Economy Working Group (\$10K). My husband (Lawrence F. Katz) receives payment for being the editor of the *Quarterly Journal of Economics*. I received an advance on my book, *Career and Family*, from Princeton University Press, but that was more than three years ago. The book generated income that is given to PUP to pay off the advance.
2. I have received prize money, all of which has been donated to a research fund at Harvard University, including the entire amount of the Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel (although that amount has not yet been transferred) and a prize shared with David Autor from the Society for Progress (\$50K) received in November 2021.
3. I have no paid or unpaid positions as officer, director, or board member related (or unrelated) to the paper being considered, neither does my husband (Lawrence F. Katz) as far as I know.
4. No other party had the right to review the paper prior to its circulation.
