We study the effects of a series of **earthquakes** that struck Mexico in September 2017 on gendered violence. **Domestic violence** increased by 17%, **sexual abuse** rose by 11%, and **rape** climbed by 12%. What are the mechanisms?

1 Motivation


- Absence of capable guardians may increase opportunities of crimes targeting women (Cohen and Felson, 1979).
- Increase of social cooperation may decrease the likelihood of crimes against women (Fritz, 1996).

2 Methods

- Data: National Public Security System (municipality-level).
- Period: Jan 2017 to Sept 2018.
- Methodology: Event-Study.
