

The first draft of the article was commissioned by the Private Enterprise Development in Low-Income Countries (PEDL) initiative (<https://pedl.cepr.org/>), a joint initiative of the Centre for Economic Policy Research and the U.K. Foreign, Commonwealth, and Development Office (FCDO), funded by FCDO. PEDL and I explicitly agreed that I would submit the paper for publication elsewhere, and I have gone far beyond the PEDL requirements in preparing the review. PEDL did not review the paper prior to submission and I have retained all rights over the content.

Since 2009, I have been serving as a Research Program Director for the International Growth Centre (IGC), a research consortium based at the London School of Economics and Oxford University.
