


FIGURE A1. TIMELINE OF THE SEMILLAS DE APEGO IMPACT EVALUATION




FIGURE A2. CONFLICT-RELATED VIOLENCE BEFORE AND AFTER THE TRUCE

Column 1 reports statistics for the full sample, while Columns 2 and 3 report statistics for the subjects (cohorts) who were assessed after and before the truce was signed. Column 4 reports the p-values of the two-sample mean differences between Columns 2 and 3.

Controls used in the econometric analysis

For estimates on the association between pre-baseline conflict and caregiver's mental health in Column 1, we control for baseline characteristics including caregivers' sex, age, and years of education.

For estimates on the association between recent conflict and caregivers' and children's mental health (Columns 3-6), we control for a range of baseline characteristics divided into three categories as follows:

- Caregivers' controls: sex, age, years of education, whether the caregiver was a formal
 worker, whether the caregiver had worked in the previous seven days, and the baseline
 mental health index.
- Household controls: asset index, two-parent household, household size, whether the household is overcrowded, and the number of children under five years old.

In addition, for estimates on children's mental health in Columns 4 and 6, we control for children's baseline characteristics including sex, age in months, birth order, weight for height Z-score, and mental health index.
